- CO5:** The course contents of English language and literature develops students overall personality through the inculcation of human values, moral values and life skills.



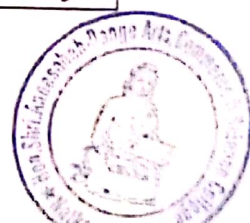
Dept. of History (UG and PG)

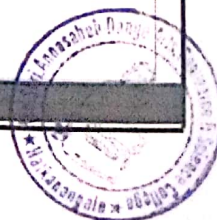
